AXIS Networks Technology ships first multiple antenna radio platform for next generation broadband wireless data networks

Single platform architecture underpins WiMAX & LTE networks worldwide

AXIS Network Technology Ltd, (AXISNT) specialists in radio products for wireless data transmission in telecoms networks, today launched its Multiple Antenna 4x4 and 8x8 remote radio platform capability for multimode wireless solutions at ITU Telecom in Geneva.

AXISNT is attending ITU Telecom thanks to a grant from UK Trade & Investment (UKTI), the Government body helping UK companies grow internationally.

The platform is a scalable hardware system, enabling the development of 4G software for WiMAX & LTE services with state-of-the-art power efficiency performance, at minimal network operator CAPEX and OPEX. This single product, building on the company's existing successful 2x2 solutions, meets the multiple product requirements of service providers in current WiMAX markets, emerging markets developing LTE/TDD data solutions and for those seeking to upgrade voice networks with LTE/FDD data solutions in the near future.

The technology needed for Remote Radio Heads (RRH), key components of next generation wireless systems, is a highly complex and demanding mix of hardware, firmware and innovative multimode software. AXIS RRH are extremely power and frequency efficient, flexible and field configurable, delivering a low cost (CAPEX and OPEX) solution for OEMs supplying network infrastructure to the telecoms industry in the USA, Asia, Africa and Europe.

“There is an explosive global growth in the demand for low cost wide area Wireless data services,” said Simon Mellor, CEO, AXIS Network Technology. “The economics of the

mobile industry has driven the need for a software defined platform-based solution that can address all the needs of LTE and WiMAX. The launch of the world's first such platform from AXISNT is the culmination of four years of research and will anchor the development of AXIS growing and vibrant WiMAX & LTE technology capability for the foreseeable future."

AXISNT also ship a complete range of commercial LTE Test Platforms for Wireless Base Station Test systems from 700MHz to 2.6GHz. The single platform enables testing of both TDD and FDD systems for the emerging broadband wireless data market.

UKTI's Tradeshow Access Programme (TAP), allows small and medium-sized enterprises to apply for six grants of up to £1,800 to participate in different overseas trade fairs to potentially secure business deals.

"More than 130 years ago a Scotsman called Alexander Graham Bell connected the world with his new invention," said UKTI CEO Sir Andrew Cahn. "The UK communications sector continues to break convention, making it the fourth largest in the world. The ITU Telecom UK Pavilion represents that unique spirit of innovation and all-round creative energy that gives the UK a real business edge."
